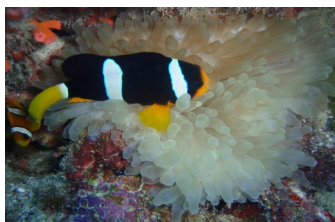

Want to learn to dive?

Now is the time to dive into the PADI Open Water Course, the most popular dive programme in the world. This is your ticket to a lifetime of intense adventure with PADI, the company that sets the standards in the global diving community.



Why PADI Open Water?

As a certified PADI Open Water diver, you have the most widely recognised and respected rating in the world. You also have the freedom to dive with a buddy independent of a professional. If you have already completed a PADI Discover Scuba Diving or are PADI Scuba Diver certified, our instructors will be happy to explain how credits from these courses can apply to the open water programme.

Who can dive?

Virtually anyone who is in good health, reasonably fit and comfortable in the water can earn a PADI Open Water certification allowing them to dive to a maximum depth of 18 metres. If you are between 10 and 14 there is a PADI Junior Open Water programme available. A PADI Open Water diver between the ages of 10-12 may only dive with a PADI professional or a certified parent /guardian to a maximum depth of 12 metres.

What will I need?

You will be issued with a PADI Crew Pack for the course you are undertaking. This provides you with all the information you need. Open Water students will also be issued with a dive log book. You will be provided with all the necessary dive equipment.

Where do the courses take place?

The theory and confined water sessions take place at the Epic Leisure Centre in Ellesmere Port, CH65 9HH. You will need swim wear, a wet suit if you have one but is not essential. The open water dives will usually take place in inland based dive centres such as Eccleston Delph (www.thedelph.com), Capernwray (www.dive-site.co.uk) or Vivian (www.divevivian.com). In good weather conditions we may use recognised sea based sites.

What will I do?

Throughout the course you will learn the fundamentals of scuba diving, including dive equipment and techniques. You will learn this by completing at least three full pool sessions and four open water dives (two per day), You will also complete knowledge reviews from the Crew Pack manual and undertake a final examination.

How long will it take?

The open water course is designed to be completed within a month. Pool sessions take place on a Wednesday evening (6pm -10pm) and open water sessions are usually on a Sunday (8am - 2pm)
